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

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FOREWORD

"Few people realize, much less appreciate, that apart from Survey of India and Geological Survey, the Census of India has been perhaps the largest single producer of maps of the Indian sub-continent" – this is an observation made by Dr. Ashok Mitra, an illustrious Census Commissioner of India in 1961. The statement sums up the contribution of Census Organisation which has been working in the field of mapping in the country.

The Census Commissionarate of India has been working in the field of cartography and mapping since 1872. A major shift was witnessed during Census 1961 when the office had got a permanent footing. For the first time, the census maps were published in the form of 'Census Atlases' in the decade of 1961-71. Alongwith the national volume, the atlases of states and union territories were also published. With the passage of time and in each subsequent census, a number of other products such as DCHB, Town Directory, migration maps, regional division maps and others were added.

During the Census 2001, GIS technology was introduced in Census Commissionarate and Census Directorates which has given a real boost in the field of mapping. Besides the regular publications, a number of new map products such as (i) India Administrative Atlas 1872-2001 – A Historical Perspective, (ii) Language Atlas of India, (iii) Housing Atlas of India, (iv) Scheduled Tribe Atlas of India and (v) Map Profile 2001 India, States and Union territories have been published. Some of the other products are in the pipeline.

Administrative Atlas, 2001 of all the States and Union territories has been undertaken for preparation, looking to the demand of DCHB maps among the data users. In this publication, maps of the state, district and sub-district levels have been put together. For convenience of the data users, the publication has been made ready in two parts : Part-I is in regard to the maps showing the evolution of States/Union territories during the period 1872-2001 at decadal level. These maps exhibit the evolution of administrative boundaries in the respective State/Union territory through the entire time period. A brief analytical note has been added to explain the jurisdictional changes to each map. Besides, there are a few thematic maps at state level showing different themes. Few selected key population statistics at States/Union territories level have also been included. Part-II is more current. The first map highlights the changes observed in the administrative boundaries during 1991-2001. This is followed by district and sub-district maps of the respective States/Union territories showing amenities and location code number in the sub-districts adopted during Census 2001 at village level. To read the location code numbers, the names of villages alongwith code numbers are given on the page facing each plate.

The gigantic task of the completion of this project was entrusted to Map Division of Census Commissionarate and respective Directorates under the supervision of Dr. R.P. Singh, Ex-Deputy Registrar General (Map) and, now, Consultant (Map). Kum. Sarita, Research Officer (Map) has

PREFACE

Although Administrative Atlas is one of the series of the Census Publications, it could not be published in the earlier Censuses. This present Administrative Atlas is the first ever published volume for the State of Manipur, in 2001 Census. In this volume, data on administrative units and their changes are mainly collected and compiled since 1872. However, maps and other information so far available are shown from the Census of 1891 to the present Census of 2001 except 1941.

The volume contains altogether 70 maps, which are divided in two parts. In the Part-I, the volume contains the Position of State in India, 11 maps at the state level showing Administrative trends from 1891 to 2001 except 1941 and another set of 10 Thematic maps showing growth of population, density, literacy, sex-ratio, workers, regional divisions, etc. In the Part-II, it contains 9 district and 38 sub-divisional maps and their administrative changes also during 1991-2001. Further a brief note on geographical location, area, administrative set up, demographic structure and socio-economic aspects, for each district map is highlighted. Hope that this volume would be able to provide some useful information to the data users and scholars and other fields as well.

In bringing out this volume, I am grateful to Shri J.K. Banthia, Former Registrar General, India & Census Commissioner for his initiative step for this project and Shri D.K. Sikri, present Registrar General, India & Census Commissioner for his inspiration. My sincere thanks are due to Dr. R.P. 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PART- I STATE


POSITION OF MANIPUR IN INDIA 2001

MAP 1

This map shows the geographical position of Manipur state in India as per Census of India 2001. Manipur is situated in the easternmost part of the north-eastern hilly region of India. It is a landlocked isolated hilly state having a distinct geographical entity. It is almost rectangular in shape with a valley encircled by hill ranges. This small valley spreads over an area of 2,007 km², which is about 9 per cent of the total area of the state. Loktak Lake, the biggest fresh lake in the north-eastern India lies in the southern part of this valley.

The total area of the state is 22,327 square kilometres, which constitute only 0.68 per cent of the total area of the Indian Union and is one of the smallest states in India. In terms of population, the state has recorded 2,293,896 persons including estimated population of 3 sub-divisions of Senapati district in 2001, which represent only 0.22 per cent of the total population

of India. It is situated between 92° 58' E and 94° 45' E longitudes and 23° 50' N and 25° 42' N latitudes. The average elevation of the valley is 790 metres above the mean sea level. The hills are spread from the north to south direction with an average height ranging between 1,500-1,800 metres. Some of the hills on the northern parts of the state have a height around 3,000 metres. The state is bounded on the north by Nagaland, on the east by Surma Tract and upper Chindwin of Myanmar (Burma), on the south by Chin Hills (Myanmar) and Mizoram and on the west by the Cachar District of Assam. According to the physical feature, the state may broadly be divided into two parts, viz., the Hills and Valley. The hills comprise of five districts, namely Senapati, Tamenglong, Churachandpur, Chandel and Ukhrul, while the districts of Bishnupur, Thoubal, Imphal West and Imphal East fall in the valley.




ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS 1891

This map shows the Administrative Divisions of Manipur State as existed in 1891. Till 1891, the state was under the direct control of the king of Manipur. According to Captain, E.W. Dun and in his book entitled – ‘Gazetteer Of Manipur’ ever published in 1886, it was mentioned that Manipur was called in different names/nomenclatures that – *Kathay* by Burmese, *Moglie* by Cachar, *Mikli* by Assam, *Kassay* by Shans, etc.

Then the state was bounded on the west by the British district of Cachar and Naga Hills District, on the north by the Naga Hills District, on the east and on the south by the Kubbo (Kabow) Valley, a portion of upper Burma (now Myanmar). As per Census of Assam, 1891 some villages like Silchar, Kohima, Old Samjok, Tamu, and Khampat were also shown as geographical spots.

ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS 1901

The map shows only the outer boundaries of Manipur State as existed in 1901. The boundaries with Burma (now Myanmar) on the east, with Naga Hills on the north, with Cachar on the west and with Lushai Hills and Burma (now Myanmar) on the south-west.

The total population of the state was recorded as 284,465 during year 1901. As per record of the then Political Agency, there was no Sub-division as existing in the present set up of Administrative Divisions, and rather it was treated as a single district state under the then Chief-Commissioner of Assam. However it can be observed that from the period 1899 to 1900 or so the area now known as Manipur state had six Panahs as


administrative units perhaps for collection of state revenues. The Panahs were 1) Ahallup, 2) Naharup, 3) Khabam, 4) Laipham, 5) Imphal, and 6) Sadar Collection and they were put under the control of a Tahsildar/Dewan more or less a Sub-Deputy Collector alike.

As history tells, Manipur was a Princely State ruled by Rajas and Maharajas successively at Imphal being the capital of Manipur state, from the earliest times. Out of the six (6) Panahs, 1 to 5 might be described as the Panahs in the plains and the remaining one (1) in the hills as a whole. But Panahs boundaries could not be defined in the map.

ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS 1911


Similar to the map of Administrative Divisions, 1901 the map of the Manipur state shows only the outer boundaries in 1911 also. However, it depicts some important spots like Karong in Mao-Sadar Hills on the north, Dabiram in the Tamenglong on the west, Changland in Churachandpur on the south, Thoubal and Bishnupur in the central area of the state. Imphal was shown as the centrally located Capital of the state. Besides, some natural big rivers of Imphal, Thoubal, Irang, Makru, Barak, Jiri, etc. were also shown as draining from north to south-westward.

As regards the extent of boundary lines, Manipur State was bounded by Naga Hills on the north, by Cachar Plains and North Cachar on the west, by Burma (now Myanmar) on the east, by Lushai Hills and Burma (now Myanmar) on the south. The state recorded a total population of 346,222 with a geographical area of 8,456 square miles during 1911 Census. It might also be evident that the same number of Panahs (6) existed in 1901, were also maintained in its entity, as administrative units in 1911.

It was recorded that the State Census was conducted in 1921, under the supervision of Shri Babu Upendra K. Chakravarti. He was an officer in the department of Revenue Division/Section. In 1911 also, status of the state administrative divisions was as such that it was a single district state, as in 1901. So, six Panahs of 1) Ahallup, 2) Naharup, 3) Khabam, 4) Laipham, 5) Imphal, and 6) Sadar Collection, as administrative units might be continued/existed. But the boundary lines of the respective Panahs could not be well defined as stated earlier.

The outer boundary lines of the state, in status quo, were demarcated with the Naga Hills on the north, with Cachar of Assam on the west, Burma (now Myanmar) on the east and Lushai Hills and Burma (now Myanmar) on the south-west. However, the distribution population was shown increasing from 346,222 to 384,016 during 1911-1921 Censuses, in the state of Manipur.

ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS 1931

In 1921 Census, the outer boundary lines of the Manipur did not show any change, and so also the area. However, the distribution of total population in the state was shown as increasing from 1,11,000 in 1911 to 1,44,560 in 1931 Census. The total area of the state was recorded as 8,620 square miles with a density of population 52 persons per square mile, which was a very thin distribution of population during that Census year. As detailed in 1931 Census, there were 2 broad sections as Valley and Hills on physiographic basis. A slight change in Panahar could be observed that there were six (6) Panahars i) Naharup Panah, ii) Ahallup Panah, iii) Imphal

Panah, iv) Khabam Panah, v) Laipham Panah and vi) Jirighat Panah in the valley and two (2) Panahs of Imphal North and Imphal South, in the hills. Jirighat Panah was added while Imphal North and South might be sub-sections (breakaway section) of the Sadar Collection Panah from the 1901 Panah Divisions.

In the map of 1931 Census, the Panah boundary lines could not be demarcated. However, some of the important names of places/villages are shown. They are worth-mentioning as Imphal (Capital), Mao-Maram, Kangpokpi, Tamenglong, Nungba, Tolbung, Churachandpur, Thoubal, Kakching, Moreh, Ukhrul, Kasom, Bishenpur, Moirang, etc.




ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS 1951

It may be stated that the 1941 Census was not properly conducted in Manipur State. This was perhaps due to the outbreak of 2nd World War.

The status of Manipur State boundaries might be stated as the same as shown in 1921 and earlier maps. Manipur was bounded by Cachar and United district of Mikir and North Cachar Hills district of Assam on the west, by the Naga Hills on the North, by Burma (now Myanmar) on the east and by Burma (now Myanmar) and Lushai Hills on the south-west. The geographical area was recorded as 8,628 square miles. After independence, 1951 Census was the first Census conducted with greater input. As per records of this

census, the state had exhibited a total of 577,635 population. As regards the Administrative Divisions, Manipur was comprised of eight (8) sub-divisions, of which, 3 were in the Plains and 5 in the Hill areas. They were Sadar, Thoubal and Jiribam sub-divisions in the Manipur Plains, and Mao, Churachandpur, Tengnoupal, Ukhru and Tamenglong sub-divisions in Manipur Hills. The change in the administrative units and its structures from Panahs to sub-divisions came into effect from 1951. Among the sub-divisions, the highest population was distributed in Sadar (270,972) and the lowest in Jiribam (7,541), in the plains, and again in the hills, the highest was in Churachandpur (42,695), and the lowest in Tengnoupal (24,049).



ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS 1961

Till 1961, Manipur was a single district Union territory, with its Capital at Imphal. It was having its outer boundary with Nagaland on the north, Assam on the west, Burma (now Myanmar) on the east, and Mizoram and Burma (now Myanmar) on the south-west.


As regards the administrative divisions of Manipur, there were 10 sub-divisions in 1961, as against 8 in 1951, viz., – Imphal West, Imphal East, Bishenpur, Thoubal, Ukhrul, Mao and Sadar Hills, Tamenglong, Jiribam, Churachandpur and Tengnoupal. As per records of 1961 Census, the area of the single district-Union

territory, was 8,628 square miles, out of which nearly 8,000 square miles are covered by the hills.

The population of the Union territory was 780,037 persons in 1961. Out of this total population, 514,667 persons or nearly two-thirds were concentrated in the valley and 265,370 persons or about one-third were spread over the surrounding hills. Among the sub-divisions, the relatively high population was found in Imphal West (178,235) and Imphal East (122,655) of the valley area, whereas Mao and Sadar Hills (72,039) and Churachandpur (62,418) in the hill areas were recorded higher population.

ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS 1971

This map shows the administrative divisions of the state of Manipur in 1971. In this map the administrative boundaries – International, State, District, Sub-Division and Block are demarcated by various line symbols as shown in the legend. The capital of the state and headquarters of the districts, sub-divisions and blocks are also shown by suitable symbols. The names of the districts and the sub-divisions are written in each administrative unit. Whenever the name of a sub-division differs from that of its administrative headquarters, the former is inserted within bracket, e.g., Tamei (Tamenglong North).

The state of Manipur has an area of 22,356.0 Km² with a total population of 1,072,753 persons in 1971. For administrative purposes, the state was divided into districts and the districts into sub-divisions-cum blocks. In 1971 Census, the administrative set up was thoroughly changed since the upgradation of sub-divisions into districts level. The new districts formed so far were 1) Manipur North, 2) Manipur west, 3) Manipur South, 4) Manipur East and 5) Manipur Central. It may also be

noted that sub-divisions of Imphal East, Imphal West, Jiribam, Bishenpur, Thoubal, Tengnoupal, Chandel and Chakpikarong were jurisdictionally included in the Manipur Central district. There are altogether five districts and twenty-five sub-divisions. It may be noted that each sub-division is co-terminous with a block unit in the state. Imphal West sub-division is however found having two block units namely Imphal West-I and Imphal West-II with their headquarters at Haorangshabal and Wangoi respectively.

In respect of the administrative functionary and activity, the deputy Commissioner is in charge of each district and exercises control and supervision over the sub-divisional officers who perform duties at the sub-divisional level. Meanwhile as noted above, each Block Development Officer, is in charge of each block unit, who is looking after the rural development and other activities for the rural community programme. In some cases, the S.D.O. is in dual charge of the sub-division as well as block unit, where both the units are co-terminous or under the invariable circumstances of the administration.

ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS 1981

This map shows the administrative divisions of the state into districts and sub-divisions, their boundaries with headquarters as existed at the time of the 1981 Census. In this map the administrative boundaries are shown by various line symbols as given in the legend. The names of the headquarters of the districts and sub-divisions and state capital are written distinctly against their relevant symbols. The names of districts and their respective headquarters are not identical in all cases.

The state covers an area of 22,327 square kilometres with a total population of 1,420,953 persons

in 1981 Census. For administrative purposes, the state was divided into six districts and the districts into twenty-five sub-divisions. The area figures for the sub-divisions in the state are not available. This may be observed that minor change was made in the administrative divisions of Manipur state during 1971-81, Censuses. From the Manipur Central district – Tengnoupal as a new district comprising sub-divisions of Tengnoupal, Chandel and Chakpikarong was created with its Headquarters being at Chandel, in 1981. With the creation of this new district, the number of districts rose to six, viz., Manipur North, Manipur West, Manipur South, Manipur East, Manipur Central and Tengnoupal.


ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS 1991

This map presents the administrative set up of the state of Manipur i.e., districts & sub-divisions, their boundaries and headquarters as existed at the time of 1991 Census. The state is bounded on the north by Nagaland, on the east by Myanmar (Burma), on the south by Mizoram and Myanmar (Burma) and on the west by the state of Assam. The Administrative boundaries viz., International, state, district and sub-division are shown with different symbols as per the legend. The state capital, district and sub-division headquarters are shown with different symbols along with their names. Wherever the names of the sub-divisions differ from the name of headquarters, the former is given in bracket.

The geographical area of the state is 22,327 km²

with a population of 1,837,149 persons according to 1991 Census. For administrative purpose, the state is divided into eight districts and thirty sub-divisions. In terms of area, Churachandpur district has the largest area of 4,570 km² or 20.47% of the total area of the state while Bishnupur is the smallest district with an area of 496 km² or 2.22%. It has been observed that during 1991 Census, the names of the districts have been modified from the earlier names as Senapati, Tamenglong, Churachandpur, Chandel, Thoubal, Bishnupur, Imphal, and Ukhrul. However, the Thoubal, Bishnupur and Imphal districts were bifurcated from the former Manipur Central District. In terms of population, Imphal district has the highest population of 711,261 (38.72%) while the lowest population is found in Chandel district (3.87%).

ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISIONS 2001


The map shows the administrative divisions of Manipur state with its districts and sub-divisions, and their respective headquarters in 2001. With the bifurcation of Imphal district into 2 districts, viz., Imphal West and Imphal East, there are 9 districts during the Census of India 2001.

The total geographical area of the state is 22,327 km² with a population of 2,293,896 persons including estimated population of 3 sub-divisions of Senapati district in 2001. In respect of population, the Imphal West district occupies the largest population size with 444,382 persons sharing 19.37% of the total population of the state in 2001 while Tamenglong district becomes the least one with 4.86%. There are 38 sub-divisions in 2001 with 8 newly upgradated/created sub-divisions after 1991 Census as – Purul created from Paomata sub-


division and Saitu-Gamphazol from Sadar Hills West sub-division in Senapati district, Nambol from Bishnupur sub-division (Bishnupur district), Lilong from Thoubal sub-division (Thoubal district), Lamshang and Patsoi from Imphal West-I sub-division (then Imphal district now Imphal West district), Keirao Bitra from Imphal East-I sub-division (then Imphal district now Imphal East district) and Machi sub-division carve-out from the Tengnoupal sub-division in Chandel district. Apart from these upgradation and creation of new sub-divisions, four sub-divisions were also renamed their earlier names as – SDO Imphal West-I as SDO Lamphelpat; SDO Imphal West-II as SDO Wangoi; SDO Imphal East-I as SDO Porompat (including some portion of Imphal East-II sub-division now Sawombung); and SDO Imphal East-II as SDO Sawombung.



GROWTH OF UA / TOWNS 2001**



CHANGES IN ADMINISTRATIVE BOUNDARIES 1991-2001

This map shows changes in administrative divisions in the state during 1991-2001. The changes in the administrative divisions are shown as per legend of the map.

During the 1991-2001, Imphal district was bifurcated into two (2) Districts of Imphal West and Imphal East under the Manipur Government order No. 6/1/73-R (PT-VIII) dated 17th June 1997 and 8 new Sub-divisions were also created. Hence there were altogether 9 districts and 38 sub-divisions in 2001 Census.

Two Sub-Deputy Collector circles were upgraded into the level of Sub-Divisional in 1993. They are Machi Sub-Division in Chandel District and Purul Sub-Division in Senapati District with its headquarters at Machi and Purul respectively.

In addition to this upgradation of two sub-divisions, six (6) sub-divisions were newly created of which, five (5) in 1997 and one (1) in 1999, as such Patsoi and Lamshang Sub-Divisions in Imphal West District (Imphal West-I sub-division of then Imphal District), Keirao Bitra

in Imphal East District (Imphal East-I sub-division of then Imphal District), Lilong in Thoubal District and Nambol in Bishnupur District created in 1997 and the Saitu-Gamphazol sub-division with its headquarters at Gamnom-Sapermaina out of the existing Sadar Hills West (Kangpokpi) Sub-division in Senapati District were created in 1999.

In 1997, the four (4) sub-divisional offices were also renamed


- 1) as SDO, Lamphelpat against SDO, Imphal West-I,
- 2) as SDO, Wangoi against SDO, Imphal West-II,
- 3) as SDO, Porompat against SDO, Imphal East-I, and
- 4) as SDO, Sawombung against SDO, Imphal East-II.
